Although most organizations do not require training, training continues to be a significant success factor



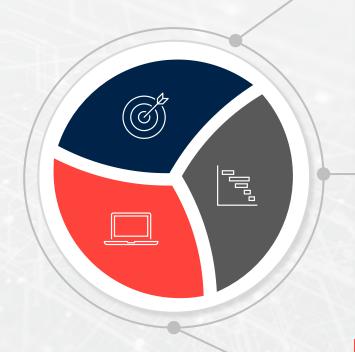
New technology adoptions in grants management has a way to go







Introduction and Methodology



Purpose

Inform the grants community of crosscutting issues and trends to **help improve** grants management and to **support advocates** for better grants management.

Survey Design

GWU, REI, and NGMA developed a survey of grants managers in 2016 to help identify key practices, major challenges, and related topics that could help inform the grants management community. Revisions were made to the survey every year to maximize the opportunity to evaluate the trend of responses over time.

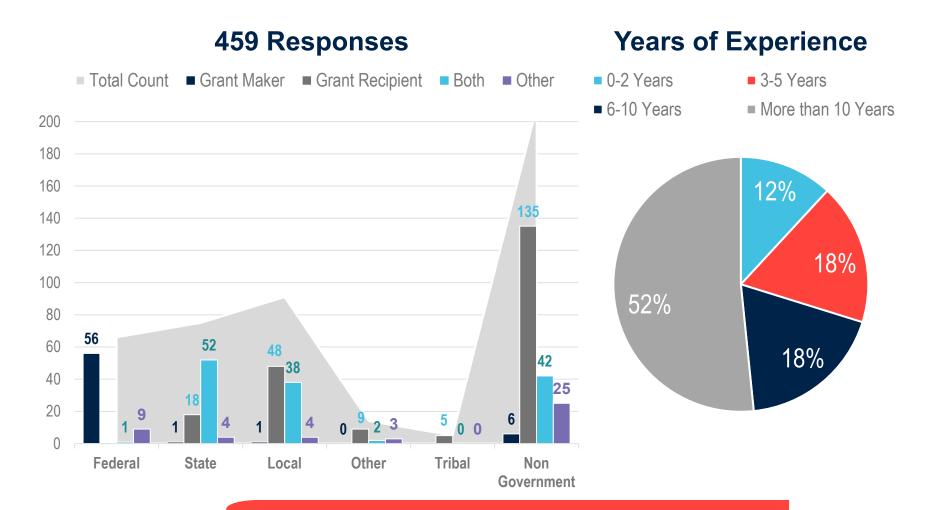
Survey Administration

More than 5,000 professionals in grants management and related fields were invited to take the survey online.





Respondents Included a Mix of Federal, State, Local, and Nonprofit Grants Managers

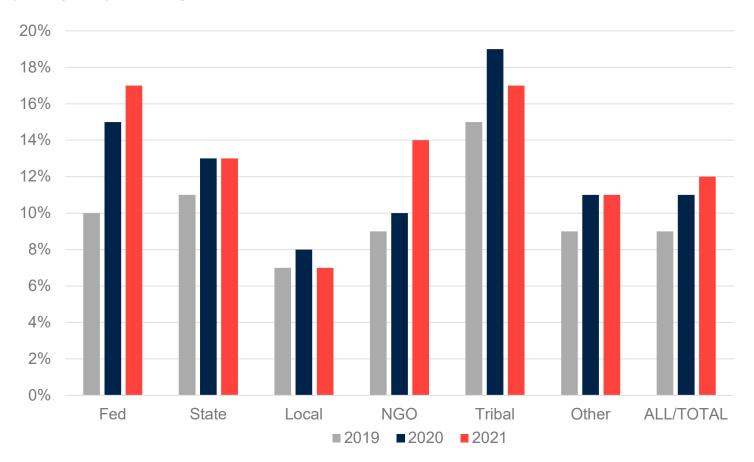




Admin Spend on Grants Management Remains High

1.4. What percentage of the annual value of grants processed by your organization does [your organization's] administrative budget constitute?

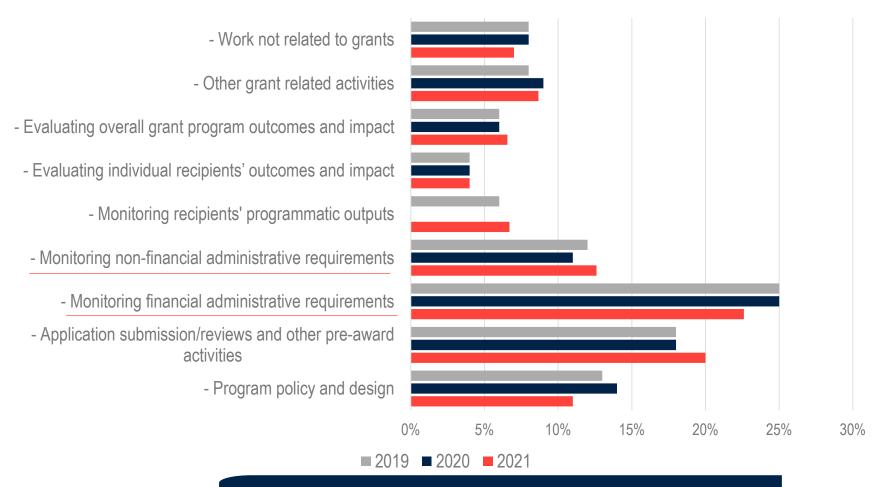
Admin spending as a percent of grant value





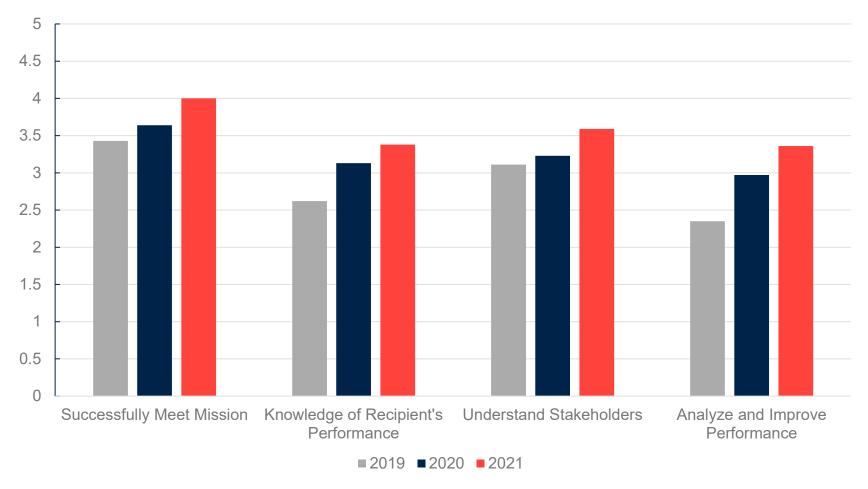
Grants Managers' Work Is Consistent: The Biggest Task Is Still Compliance Monitoring

2.1. How much time do you spend on the following grants management activities?



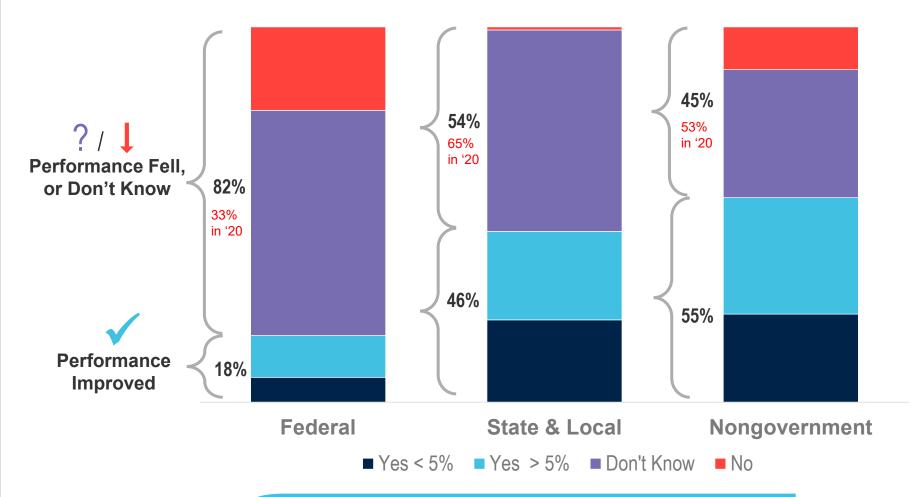
Organizational Ability to Meet Mission Objectives Improved

2.2. What is your assessment of how well equipped your organization and its operational environment is?



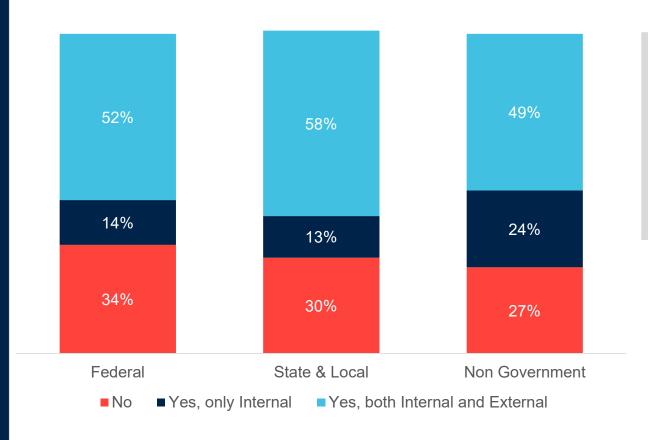
Many More Organizations Experienced Falling or Unknown Performance Than in Previous Years

2.5 Has your organization changed its operations (beyond just remote work) as a result of the pandemic?



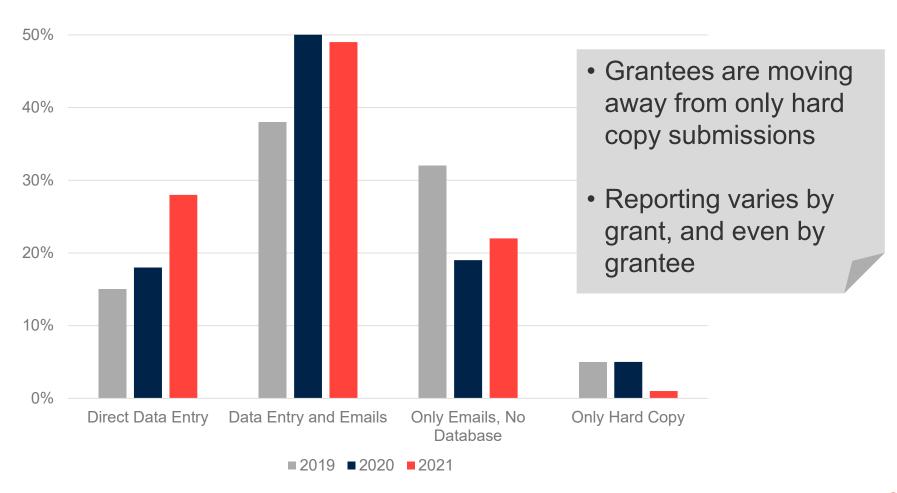

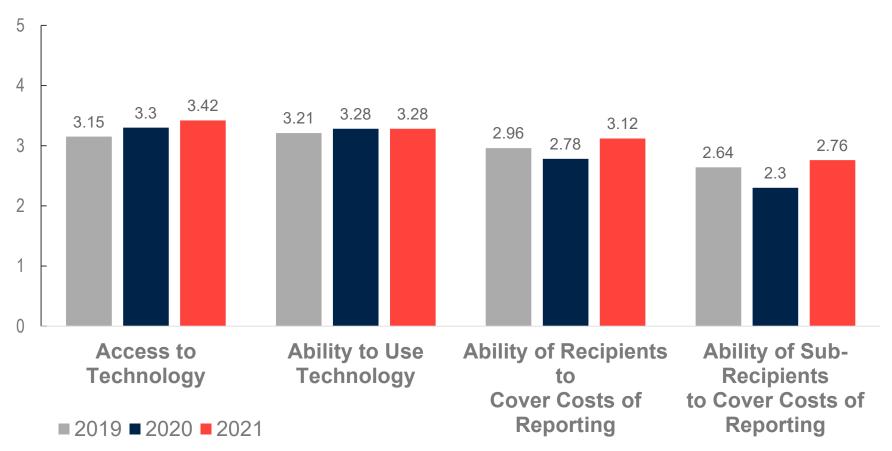
3.2 How would you describe the method used by your grantees to submit reporting?





Satisfaction with Technology and Ability of Recipients to Cover Costs Is Showing Some Improvement

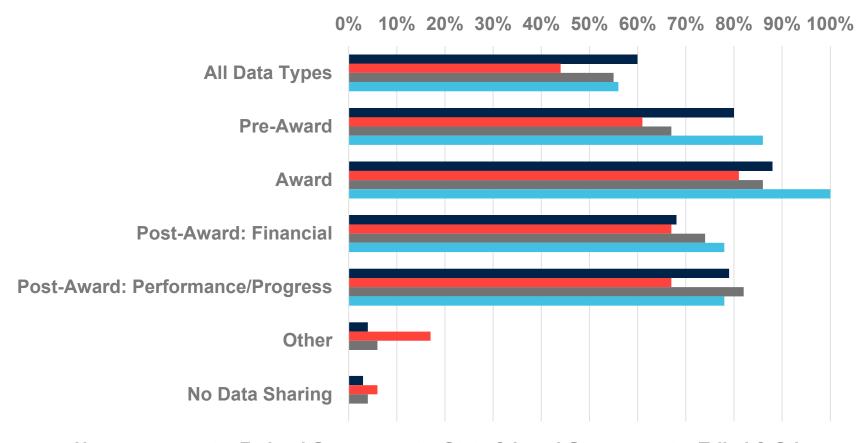

3.5 What kind of data should local, state, and tribal governments and federal agencies share in an automated manner?

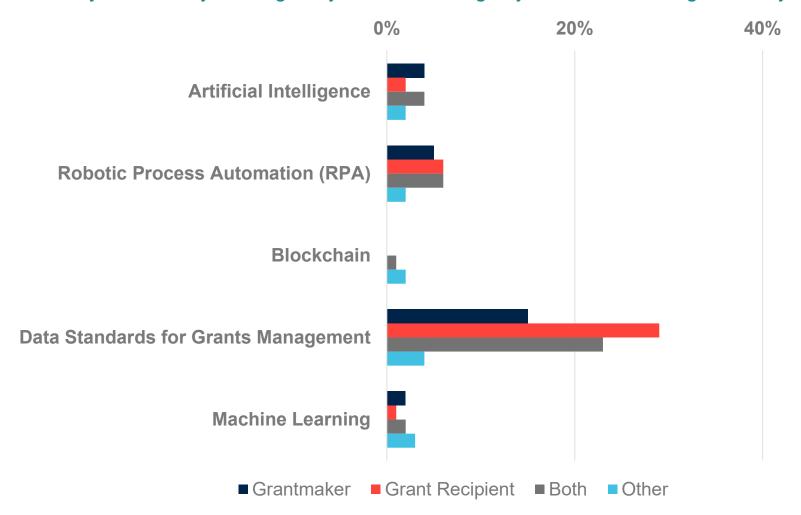






Grantmakers and Recipients Are Not Leveraging the Latest Advances in Technology

3.6 Do you currently leverage any of the following in your Grants Management Systems?



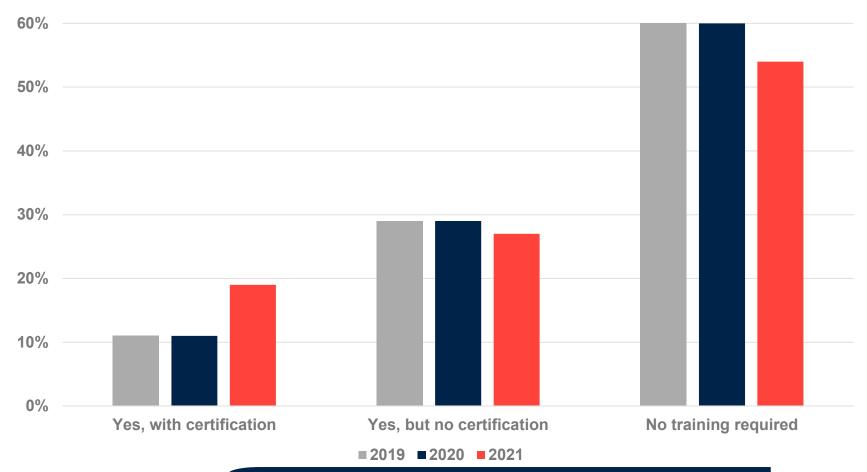




Few Organizations Require That Their Staff Receive Grants Management Training

4.1 Does your organization require formal grant training of your staff?



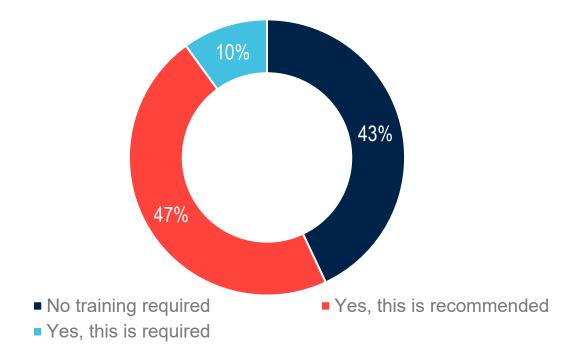


About Half of Organizations Offer Grant Training to Grant Recipients

4.2 Does your organization provide grant training to grant recipients or sub-recipients?

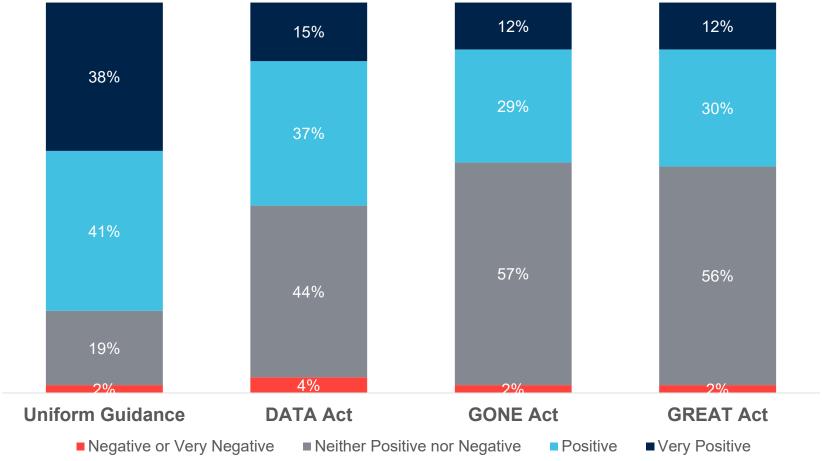

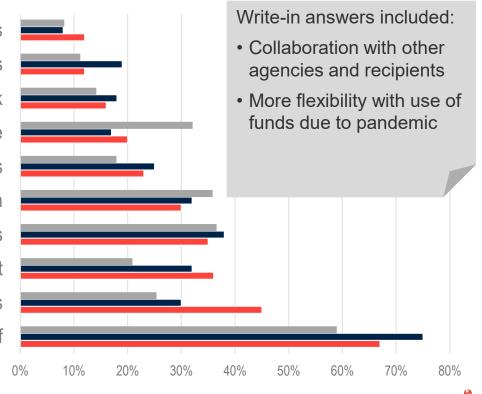

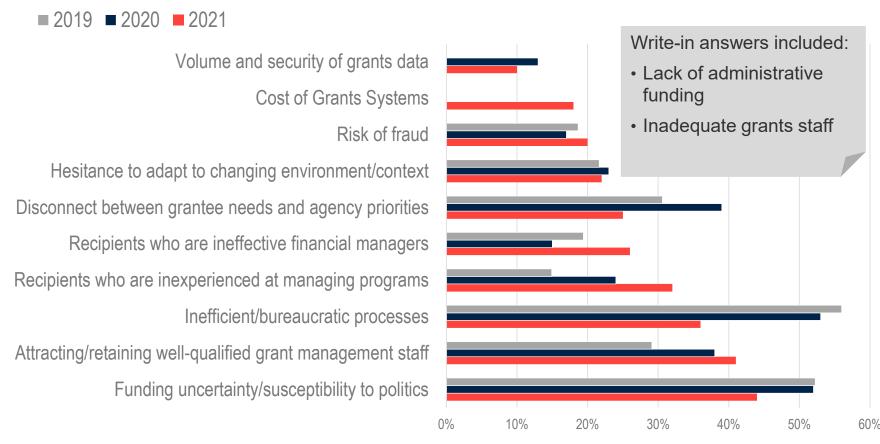

PEOPLE

- → Better training
- → Certifications for both Grantmakers and Recipients
- → Experienced staff
- → Leadership expectations



PROCESS

- → Communication
- → Clear expectations from Grantmakers
- → Standardizing processes
- → "Right-sizing" reporting requirements



TECHNOLOGY

- → Modernized systems
- → Standardized data
- → Automation in data reporting
- → Streamlined systems, fewer portals



6.5. What are your top 5 priorities over the next 3 years?

Increasing staff, more training, and streamlining processes continue to be priorities.





Takeaways from Our Analysis

- Grants managers continue to spend more time monitoring compliance than any other activity
- As Grantmakers improve reporting automation, satisfaction with technology is slowly increasing

- 2 54% of respondents said that performance outcomes did not improve, or they didn't know if they did
- The Uniform Guidance has made a big impact on daily grants management activities

3 82% said that changes that were made for the pandemic are permanent

6 Systems, training, and efficient processes remain priorities
