For Success Criterion 1.4.3, this technique describes the minimum contrast ratio for text that is less than 18 point (if not bold) and less than 14 point (if bold). For Success Criterion 1.4.5, this technique relaxes the 7:1 contrast ratio requirement for text that is at least 18 point (if not bold) or at least 14 point (if bold).</p> <p>As a best practice: When evaluating the right contract definition, the font size in points should be obtained from the calculated font metrics. Point sizes are based on the CSS pt. size (CSS3 values). The ratio between sizes in points and CSS pixels is 1pt = 1.333px; therefore, 14pt and 18pt are equivalent to approximately 18.5px and 24px.
