HHS Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA)

The Utah State Board of Education (USBE)

USBE provides programmatic and fiscal grant support across the state of Utah. It manages \$4.5 billion in grants on over 40 error-prone spreadsheets. The system was fraught with overpayments, non-compliance, and a lack of transparency. GovGrants automated the entire lifecycle, optimizing USBE's labor and payment operations.
